### Life 2026

"Ever feel like something's missing?"

Do you remember a time when you were asking yourself that question, and would have had to answer 'yes'?



Jesus said, "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." (John 10:10).

St John's and Emmanuel exist with a purpose: to help people discover the life that there is in Jesus. Many of our neighbours have not discovered what it is that's missing, but would admit to some kind of emptiness and searching.

Beginning in March 2026 we're going to join hundreds of churches for a nationwide gospel mission, asking that question (top right is a preview of the kind of publicity you'll see around, including images of everyday objects missing a key component!). The mission will be what we make of it (there's no-one else to run it for us! \*) so, we need to begin preparing soon. Expect to hear more about this from September. \* we may find ways to work together with other local churches in Surrey Gospel Partnership, but let's aim to be drivers, not passengers, if that happens!

A rough timeline for our preparation is as follows:

- Now volunteer to join the small committee to plan our mission.
- Autumn 2025 use personal witness training resources at 6:30 and in home groups. Ideas for events submitted to the mission committee. Every group in church (home groups, First Steps, DKC, Thursday Fellowship, Cameo, etc.) challenged to come up with at least one idea and run it.
- January 2026 Lots of prayer. Print and digital publicity in local community.
- March 2026 Mission week.
- April 2026 onward follow-up (personal, and Christianity Explored) and ongoing evangelism.

Of course, evangelism is always our business as Christians. But many churches find that a focused week and 'something to work towards' fires our enthusiasm and becomes a springboard to a more evangelistically engaged culture. We trust that will prove to be the case here too, and that the Lord will honour our faithful attempts to glorify His name.
